Preteens are at a key transitional point in their lives where they want to experience God, are interested in service and mission, and are looking for a way to express their spirituality. Our goal is to provide a fun, consistent, safe, intimate, and focused environment that will engage them where they are and prepare them for transition to the Student Ministry when they reach seventh grade.**

# **PRETEEN WEEKLY MINISTRIES**

## **Sunday School**

Fifth and Sixth graders meet in the Preteen room (PC 101) where they utilize Flyte curriculum to study age-appropriate Bible topics through games, music, Bible study, discussion groups, and much more.

## **Worship Service**

Preteens are released from their Sunday School room to head to the main worship service. They are not required to have a parent check them out. They are encouraged to sit with their families or friends and actively engage in the worship service. This is an important time for preteens to become active members of worship instead of merely observers.

## **Wednesday Evenings**

Preteens meet in the Preteen room and are led in live worship, followed by Bible study, discussion groups, games, and more. The programming of Wednesday evenings is intentionally designed to be more closely aligned to a youth Wednesday night service. There is a small snack shack set up for preteens to buy a variety of snacks. All proceeds go toward missions.

# **PRETEEN SPECIAL EVENTS**

## **Preteen Summer Camp**

Preteen Camp is for children who have completed fifth and sixth grade. Preteens will participate in a camp experience specifically tailored for their age group. Preteen camp is 5 days long and includes Bible study, ropes courses, target sports, water activities, swimming, worship, mission opportunities, and epic games.

## **Vacation Bible School**

Vacation Bible School runs on a Sunday through Thursday from 6:30—8:45 p.m.! VBS is for kids 3 years (and potty-trained) to 6th grade and it is an incredible time of learning about God and our relationship with Him. The 5th and 6th graders will be in their very own Preteen Week and participate in lots of great activities. On the Sunday after VBS, we have a Commencement & Luncheon where we celebrate with our families what God has done throughout the week.

## **Fall Frolic**

Fall Frolic is a great event for families from birth through 101! We will have inflatables, concessions, and Trunk or Treat Cars on the front Parking lot. Non-scary costumes only please!

## **Preteen Events**

## **REDUCING THE RISK POLICY**

WRBC is committed to providing a safe environment for all children. All teachers and volunteers in the Preteen Ministries Department must follow the Reducing the Risk policy which includes training, background checks, and additional screening. ## **GUIDELINES & EXPECTATIONS**

Our desire is to help our fifth and sixth graders grow in their faith and begin to live out their personal relationship with God through Bible study, music, service and prayer. Because our goal is for the preteens to live out their faith, we have expectations in regards to behavior. We encourage them to consider the consequences of their actions (both good and bad) and dialogue with them about the choices God gives us and whether the choices we made were honoring to God. When a preteen chooses not to follow the expectations that are laid out, we correct with love and direction.

We expect and encourage our preteens to actively participate in worship services. We believe in servant leadership and have set up a Preteen Service program where preteens can volunteer to serve in the church by taking on specific assistant jobs in the Childhood Ministry Department. Jobs include greeting at the PC Doors, Children's Church Media Assistants, Check in Assistants, and more.
